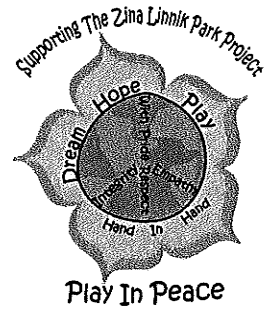

Dear First Lady Obama

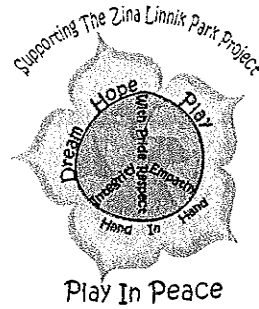
My name is Tiaira and I am in a group called peacemakers. I am writing this letter to ask you to please come to our ceremony for the park

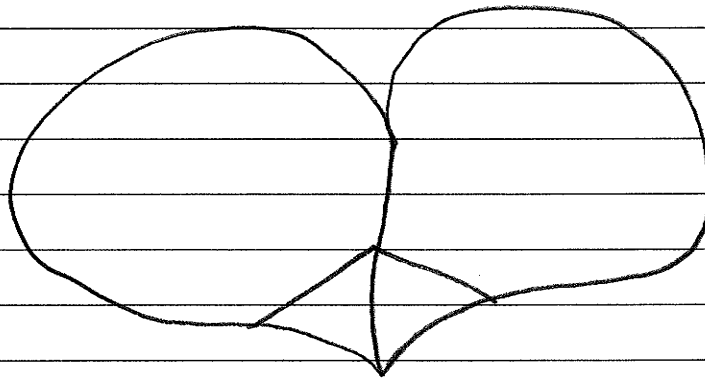

Dear Mrs. Obama

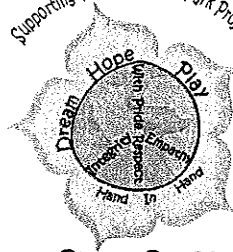

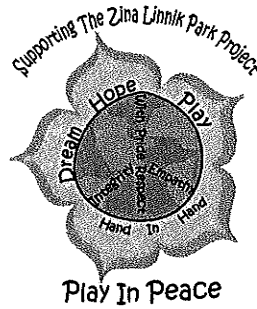
Dear First Lady Obama

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Obama,

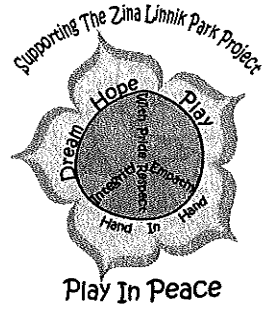

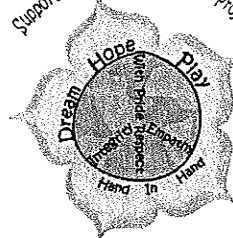


Dear Michelle Obama

Play In Peace

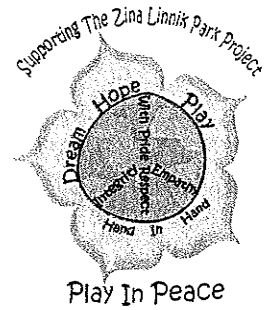
Dear President Obama
